## Garching-Based Zeppelin Apprentices Fulfill Christmas Wishes: "Wishing Tree" Initiative Brings Joy to Hundreds

In their place, countless small and large presents now lie beneath the branches. As a result, more than 100 people will receive a Christmas gift this year. The Malteser relief organization will now distribute the presents.
